

SERVICES AT SAINT MICHAEL AND ALL ANGELS

The worship life at Saint Michael and All Angels is rich and varied. We worship through our prayer life, our celebration of the Eucharist and our many programs that provide outreach into the parish, the community and the world. "Liturgy" in Greek means "the work of the people." Thus we strive to offer our very best in terms of personal preparation, participation, praise and service. Our liturgy comforts, challenges and empowers us to live our lives faithfully.

WEEKDAY SERVICES:

7:00 AM DAILY - EUCHARIST (RITE I or II) - BISHOP MOORE CHAPEL

A traditional Rite I or II Eucharist, according to the day, is held each Monday through Friday at 7:00 a.m. in the Bishop Moore Chapel. At the Celebrant's discretion a short homily may be given. *This service uses the Book of Common Prayer.*

6:00 PM DAILY - EVENING PRAYER (RITE I)- BISHOP MOORE CHAPEL

A service of Evening Prayer is led by lay readers at 6:00 p.m. each Monday through Friday in the Bishop Moore Chapel. Intercessory prayer is offered for those on the Parish's prayer list.

10:00 AM WEDNESDAYS- HEALING/EUCHARIST- BISHOP MOORE CHAPEL

A member of the clergy officiates at a service for healing with Eucharist in the Bishop Moore Chapel each Wednesday at 10:00 a.m. *This service uses a special service leaflet.*

SATURDAY SERVICES:

8:00 AM - EUCHARIST (RITE I) - BISHOP MOORE CHAPEL

A traditional Rite I Eucharist is held each Saturday at 8:00 a.m. in the Bishop Moore Chapel. At the Celebrant's discretion a short homily may be given. *This service uses the Book of Common Prayer.*

5:30 PM - CANDLELIGHT MASS (MODIFIED RITE II) - CHURCH OR CHAPEL

The Candlelight Mass is a modified Rite II Eucharist held on Saturday evenings, typically in either the Church or Saint Michael Chapel (look for information regarding the location in the Sunday News and also posted in the Church building). The service is reflective and contemplative with guitar accompaniment. When the service is held in the Church those attending are seated around the altar in monastic fashion. *This service uses a special service leaflet.*

SUNDAY SERVICES:

7:30 AM - EUCHARIST (RITE I) - SAINT MICHAEL CHAPEL

The 7:30 a.m. service is a traditional Rite I Eucharist held in the Saint Michael Chapel. *This service uses the Book of Common Prayer and Hymnal.*

8:45 AM - EUCHARIST (RITE II) - CHURCH

The 8:45 a.m. service in the Church is a traditional Rite II Eucharist. Traditional Anglican music accompanied by the Church's organ is provided by the Saint Dunstan's Choir, which consists of both children and adults. Children and parents who prefer a more formal service are among those who attend, as well as a large cross-section of adults. Lectors and acolytes serving at this service are typically teenage parishioners. *This service uses the Book of Common Prayer and Hymnal.*

9:00 AM - DISCOVERY MASS (MODIFIED RITE II) - SAINT MICHAEL CHAPEL

The Discovery Mass is a Rite II Eucharist that has been modified for children 5-10 years old and their families. The service has blended worship music with guitar, band and organ and singing by the Senior Cherub Choir. Children serve as acolytes and lay readers for the service. The preacher typically invites the children to sit near the communion rail during the sermon. Families volunteer to serve as ushers. *This service uses a special service leaflet.*

9:00 AM - JOY MASS (MODIFIED RITE II) - PARISH HALL

The Joy Mass is a modified Eucharist designed for children 3-5 years old and their families. The service is held in the Parish Hall. The atmosphere is informal. Music is contemporary, with keyboard and singing by the Junior Cherub Choir. Children are invited to sit in front of the altar during the sermon and during the first part of the Eucharist. Families volunteer to serve as ushers. *This service uses a special service leaflet.*

10:10 AM - HEALING SERVICE - BISHOP MOORE CHAPEL

A member of the clergy officiates at a short service for healing in the Bishop Moore Chapel each Sunday. *This service uses a special service card.*

11:00 AM - EUCHARIST (RITE I) - CHURCH

The 11:00 a.m. service in the Church is a traditional Rite I Eucharist. Traditional Anglican choral music with organ and the Oratorio Choir is a central part of the service. A cross-section of the parish attends this service, which uses the *Book of Common Prayer and Hymnal.*

11:00 AM - CELEBRATION MASS (CONTEMPORARY RITE II) - THEATER

The Celebration Mass is a "contemporary" Rite II Eucharist held in either the Parish Hall or Theater (look for information regarding the location in the Sunday News and also posted in the Church building). Service music is contemporary and contemplative, accompanied by keyboard. This service draws from a diverse group of parishioners who prefer a less formal, relaxed service. Families volunteer to serve as ushers. *This service uses a special leaflet and the Gather Hymnal.*

5:30 PM - EVENING PRAYER/EUCHARIST (RITE I) - SAINT MICHAEL CHAPEL

The 5:30 p.m. service in the Saint Michael Chapel is a traditional Rite I Evening Prayer and Eucharist. The service has traditional music with organ. Worshipers often attend in casual attire to end their weekend in a relaxed setting. *This service uses the Book of Common Prayer and Hymnal.*
